

Brewing in Pilsen

Almost everybody knows that Pilsen is the birthplace of brewing. During the tour of the Brewery Museum you will learn about the history of brewing in our country as well as abroad.

There are also tutorials named "Chapters from the history of the city of Pilsen I. – How to build a city" and "The forgotten crafts" Worksheets and certificates documenting their completion are part of both the programs. Students may take them home as souvenirs.

Programs are intended for students of 1st and 2nd grades of primary schools. The length of the program is 90 minutes.

How to get to the ...

Brewery Museum

Veleslavínova 6, 301 14 Pilsen

- From the Central Bus Station
 - go through the underpass to stop for tram 2 in the direction of Světovar and get off at the stop náměstí Republiky ("Republic Square"). Go across the square and turn right at Pražská and then left at Perlová streets, at which end you will be in front of the entrance to the Brewery Museum
- From the Main Railway Station
 - information boards in the underpass near the railway station show you how to reach the tram stop for trams 1 and 2, in the direction of Bolevec and Skvrňany, respectively. Get off at the stop náměstí Republiky ("Republic Square") go back about 50 meters and turn left at Perlová, which takes you to the entrance of the Museum

Pilsner Urquell Brewery

U Prazdroje 7, 304 97 Pilsen

- From the Central Bus Station
 - go through the underpass to the stop for tram 2 in the direction of Světovar and get off at the stop “hlavní nadraží ČD, Sirková “(by the main train station). Go up the escalator, pass the courthouse and continue around the hotel building to the foot bridge, which takes you straight to the brewery
- From the Main Railway Station
 - after leaving the station, turn right, go past the station wall to the next road, cross it and go past the courthouse to reach the foot bridge that leads to the brewery

The way from the brewery to the Brewery Museum takes you through Štruncovy sady (park) and walking at a leisurely pace takes 10 minutes.

Parking

The Brewery and the Brewery Museum are 5 minutes apart on foot and they are in the city centre. There can be a problem with parking. We recommend parking at the Na Rychtářce garage. Buses can park on the premises of the brewery after getting permission.
